

Petition

for a new UCI Ranking

We ask the UCI to change the Mountain Bike UCI ranking for the season 2007. The new system of 2006 is in our eyes bad for the Mountain Bike sport and brings a lot of disadvantages to the riders, teams, organizers and the media.

Here is our suggestion for a new ranking system:

Point 1 – the update

- 1.1 the UCI publish during the season every Wednesday a new ranking with the results of the last week-end.
- 1.2 the UCI is responsible for ensuring that all results will be included for calculation each Wednesday.
- 1.3 Should be continuous and not end at December 31 each year. Mountain Biking is not a Northern Hemisphere sport only. It is practiced all year round.

Point 2 – the system

- 2.1 the new ranking will take all results from the last 12 months, back from the date of the new update.
- 2.2 the new systems looks at the date only (i.e. the 1st world cup of '07 will not be immediately replaced by the 1st world cup of '08 if they are different dates)

Point 3 – the races

- 3.1 the new ranking will include these races:
 - Olympic Games
 - World Championships
 - Continental Championships
 - World Cups
 - National Championships
 - All HC races
 - 2 x Stage races (best 2 for each rider)
 - 6 x Class 1 races (best 6 for each rider)
 - 4 x Class 2 races (best 4 for each rider)
